



STATE SUPPORT FOR LOCAL CLIMATE ACTION

Climate Smart Communities (CSC) is a New York State program that supports local governments in leading their communities to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, adapt to the effects of climate change, and thrive in a green economy. The benefits of participating include leadership recognition, free technical assistance, and access to grants. Local governments participate by signing a voluntary pledge and using the CSC framework to guide progress toward creating attractive, healthy, and equitable places to live, work, and play.

Climate Smart Communities (CSC) Program Goals

- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- Build resilience to the impacts of climate change.
- Save taxpayer dollars.
- Increase energy security and reliability.
- Improve community public health and safety.
- Support a green innovation economy.
- Demonstrate leadership.

How do communities benefit from the CSC program?

- Receive funding for climate change mitigation and adaptation projects via the DEC CSC Grant program.
- Reduce the cost of clean vehicles and associated charging/fueling stations with rebates and grants via the DEC Municipal Zero-emission Vehicle program.
- Receive free technical assistance for clean energy and climate change initiatives from regional Climate Smart Communities Coordinators.



- Discover online guidance and decision-support tools via the CSC web portal.
- Learn about best practices through CSC webinars.
- Network with like-minded community leaders at CSC events and workshops.
